2020 was the **28th annual Habitat 500 Bike Ride** to raise funds and awareness for decent, affordable housing and the first Habitat 500 Bike Ride to go virtual!

## **Rider Facts & Demographics**

- 144 total riders plus 14 volunteers and support staff members participated.
- 38% of our riders were **new** and 62% were **returning**.
- Youngest Rider: 5 years old | Most senior Rider: 80 years old
- 12 riders were 25 years old or younger
- 16 riders were 70 years old or older
- Average rider age: 51 (down from 56 in 2019)
- Gender breakdown: 50.7% Female; 47.9% Male; 0.7% non-conforming; 0.7% prefer not to say
- Riders joined virtually from all over the country, including Minnesota, Illinois, Iowa, Indiana, Missouri, Michigan, Ohio, Wisconsin, Washington, Texas, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, and as far away as Guatemala!

#### Milestones

- Three participants celebrated their **15**<sup>th</sup> **year** with the Ride.
- Three participants celebrated their 10<sup>th</sup> year with the Ride.

# **Virtual Events and Groups**

- During the week of virtual events, there was an average of 33 people participating in each evening program. In total, 70 of the registered participants joined at least one virtual event.
- The Habitat 500 Facebook group has 71 members and the Habitat 500 Strava group has 29 members.

### **Funds Raised**

- Since Habitat Minnesota took over the coordination of the Habitat 500 in 2002, the Ride
  has raised over \$6.4 million for Habitat home construction and repair projects locally
  and globally.
- Total funds raised in 2020: \$283,300.
- Participants fundraised for 40 different Habitat affiliates.
- Over 2,300 donations were made to the Ride.
- Total sponsorships: \$24,370
- Average raised per rider (non-team riders): \$2,124
- Average raised per rider (team riders): \$1,360
- Riders who raised over \$10,000: Lilah Aas, Donna Kummer, Ruth Lunde, Steve O'Malley, Anne Robin
- Top Fundraiser: Ruth Lunde raised over \$19,600
